ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed by the petitioner – wife for transfer of Petition No. 123 of 2018 titled “Nidhi Singh vs Virender Singh” from the Court of the Additional District Judge (Matrimonial Case), Jammu to the Family Courts at East District, New Delhi.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of this case, particularly the fact that the petitioner would be put to considerable inconvenience in prosecuting the matter at Jammu, we think it appropriate to transfer the aforesaid case from the Additional District Judge (Matrimonial Cases), Jammu to the Family Court, East District, New Delhi.

Accordingly, the Writ Petition is allowed.

After transfer of the petition, the transferee Court is directed to make all endeavour either for amicable settlement by mediation or for early decision in the matter without unnecessary adjournments. Parties shall cooperate in seeking recourse to mediation proceedings before the Family Court.
