Heard Ms. Maheravish Rein, the learned counsel for the petitioners. She submits that the petitioners belong to the Scheduled Caste and several complaints have been filed to the Authorities and other offences alleged against the petitioners but no action was taken. She further submits that the petitioner No.1 had earlier come to this Court in W.P.(Cr1.) No. 349 of 2019 which was listed on 17.12.2020 and the Hon'ble Court had passed the following order:

"We are not inclined to entertain this writ petition. However, it shall be open for the petitioner to seek remedy as provided under law.

The writ petition is dismissed with the above observation."

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner No.1 has not been able to obtain any relief. We are of the view that the petitioners may seek remedy available to them under Section 156(3) of Cr.P.C. or such other remedy as available under law.

This Writ Petition is dismissed with the above observation.
