O R D E R

The petitioner/wife has sought intervention of this Court for transfer of Divorce Case No.500 of 2017 filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent. The petitioner/wife sought transfer of the said matrimonial proceeding to Family Court Alibag, District Raigad, Maharashtra.

During the pendency of the present proceedings, the parties were referred to mediation. The parties agreed before the mediator for settlement of their dispute by dissolution of marriage. In pursuance of such settlement, parties have jointly filed an application for grant of divorce by mutual consent.

As a part of settlement, a sum of Rs.35,00,000/- (Rupees thirty-five lakh) stands paid to the petitioner/wife. In terms of the settlement, the wife has transferred half share of property by virtue of a gift deed to the husband.

There is one domestic violence case filed by the wife which is pending before the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Mahad, District Raigad, Maharashtra. In terms of the settlement arrived at between the parties and on joint application, the proceedings of the domestic violence case stand quashed.

Since all issues between the parties stand settled, the marriage solemnized between the parties is dissolved in exercise of the powers conferred to this Court under Article 142 of the Constitution of India.

With the aforesaid directions, the transfer petition is disposed of.
