O R D E R

1. The instant petition is filed by the wife seeking transfer of Divorce Petition being Case No.93 of 2019 titled as "*Shri Sumit Sahni v. Smt.Sukriti Dabla*" pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Dehradun, Uttarakhand to the competent Court of Principal Judge, Family Court (North West), Rohini Court Complex, New Delhi.

2. The respondent though served has not chosen to appear and oppose the instant petition. In that light, the matter is taken up for consideration.

3. Having perused the petition papers and on hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, I am of the opinion that the prayer made in the petition is liable to be granted. 5. On receipt of the case records, the transferee Court shall issue fresh notice to the parties and thereafter proceed with the matter in accordance with law.

6. The transfer petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
