A W A R D

1. The parties have arrived at a settlement before the District

Legal Services Authority, Kozhikode on 08.07.2024. The settlement has been identified by the Secretary of DLSA, Kozhikode and has been signed by the parties. The parties have agreed as follows:

"1. We have settled our dispute amicably and voluntarily in the Pre-Special Lok Adalat Conciliation meeting held on 08.07.2024 at DLSA Kozhikode level by its Secretary Smt. Ancy T. and Sri. Rajesh K., MACT District Judge, Kozhikode.

2. The terms of settlement is as under:

Petitioner No.1 to 4 present, Respondent No.2, 3, 5 represented, R6 present. Matter settled for Rs.13,00,000/- (Rupees Thirteen Lakhs only). R6 shall pay the amount within one month from today to the bank account of the petitioner in the ratio 1:3:3:3. The bank details are as follows:

3. We have read and understood the terms of settlement/the terms of settlement have been read over and explained to us in the language malayalam which we have understood and we wholeheartedly accept the same.

4. Based on terms of settlement we request our matter be placed before the Hon'ble Special Lok Adalat bench at the Supreme Court of India on any date from 28th July to 3rd August 2024.

5. We would attend Special Lok Adalat proceeding at the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India physically/virtually on the date of Special Lok Adalat."

2. Since the parties have settled the dispute, the present proceedings shall stand disposed of in terms of the settlement.

3. The settlement agreement shall form part of the Award.
