O R D E R

Heard the learned Senior Counsel/Counsel appearing for the parties.

Learned counsel appearing for the appellants submits that they have completed 80-90% of the work i.e. raising the pedestrian pathway, which is under their control, and is in the process of completion of the entire stretch of land except on certain portion of the land, which is under the process of land acquisition by the second respondent-Municipal Council of Lonovala.

Learned counsel appearing for the second respondent submits that the Municipal Council of Lonovala has initiated proceedings for acquiring the land and it would take six months time to acquire the same. We have been informed by learned counsel appearing for the parties that, thereafter, it will take two months to complete the construction.

Having regard to the submissions made, we grant eight months time finally to complete the pedestrian pathway, as directed by this Court on 16.02.2017.

Interim protection granted on 29.09.2006 shall continue to operate for a further period of 8 months from today.

Applications are disposed of in the above terms.
