



3. We have heard the arguments advanced and have considered the matter. Taking into account the facts and circumstances in which the deposit was made we are of the view that the claim of interest which has been quantified at Rs.24 crore (Rupees Twenty Four crore) ought to be adjudicated in favour of the respondent to the extent of 50% of the said amount i.e. a sum of Rs.12 crore (Rupees Twelve crore). We order accordingly. The appellant shall pay the said amount to the respondent within a period of four weeks from today.

4. The appeal shall stand disposed of in the above terms.
