UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

The finding that the divorce is on the ground of desertion by the petitioner and she deserted the respondent/husband without any sufficient cause has become final. There is no case that the respondent/husband neglected or failed to maintain the petitioner/wife despite her willingness to stay with him.

Without such a finding, it will be difficult for the petitioner/wife to maintain a case for maintenance from the respondent/husband.

In that view of the matter, we do not find any ground to

interfere with the impugned order of the High Court. The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
