UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

We are inclined to restore the order of bail in
view of the statement made on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner will deposit a sum of Rs.
10,00,000/- (Rs. Ten lakhs) with the Trial Court within

a period of four weeks. The amount may be withdrawn by respondent no.2 - wife unconditionally so that she can meet immediate requirement for herself and the child. The said amount will be subject to adjustment in any future proceedings. The parties are free to reach mutual settlement for rehabilitation, as was earlier proposed.

Accordingly, the order of bail will stand restored subject to above stipulations.

The pending proceedings may be completed by the trial Court, as far as possible within a period of three months, as already directed by the High Court.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
