We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the impugned judgment and order dated 19.08.2017 passed in Matters Under Article 227 No.5022/2017. We do not find any good ground to interfere with the said order and accordingly, the Special Leave Petition is dismissed.

However at the request of learned counsel for the petitioner, six months' time is granted to the petitioner to hand over peaceful and vacant possession of the premises in question to the respondent

on filing usual undertaking within a period of two weeks from today.

The petitioner shall also pay arrears of rent/*mesne* profits till date within a month from today. He shall also continue to pay *mesne* profits for the period of six months till handing over the vacant possession of the premises.
