We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The incident, in respect of which the charge of impersonation has been leveled against the appellant, allegedly occurred in the year 2009. The appellant is the person who is supposed to have been impersonated by one Abdul Tawwab, who has been convicted and sentenced. The appellant has, in the meantime, qualified as a doctor and has also been employed. The appellant has been in custody for the last eight months.

Taking into account the aforesaid facts, we are inclined to release the accused-appellant on bail in connection with F.I.R. No.RC 217 2016 S004, on satisfaction of the appropriate condition(s) as may be imposed by the learned trial court.

Consequently, the order of the High Court is set aside and the present appeal is allowed in above terms.
