O R D E R

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the High Court has proceeded on the basis that the petitioners had filed Writ Petition merely to challenge the notice. That is factually incorrect, as in prayer Clause (ii), the petitioners had also challenged the final order passed by the competent authority dated 17.09.2019. That aspect has not been considered by the High Court.

If this is the grievance of the petitioners, it is open to the petitioners to approach the High Court by way of Review Petition.

We permit the petitioners to withdraw the Special Leave Petition and approach the High Court for filing the Review Petition.

If the Review Petition is decided against the petitioners, it will be open to the petitioners to challenge the said decision as well as the impugned judgment by way of Special Leave petition before this Court.

The Special Leave Petition is allowed to be withdrawn, as prayed, with aforesaid liberty.
