O R D E R

Parties have filed application for disposing of the special leave petition in light of settlement arrived at between them as recorded in Memorandum of Understanding dated 27.06.2019. Translated copy of description of the suit property, subject matter of the agreement, is produced before the Court, the same is taken on record.

In the circumstances, we dispose of the petition in terms of the memorandum of understanding produced in Court on condition that the petitioners shall produce power of attorney in favour of petitioner No.1 executed by petitioner Nos.4 to 10, to be filed in the Registry within two weeks.

Subject to the above, liberty is given to the parties to withdraw the amount along with interest accrued thereon deposited in this Court and district Court respectively in terms of the agreement. The Registry need not renew the Fixed Deposit Receipts; instead shall release the amount when applied by the concerned party upon compliance of the aforementioned condition of producing power of attorney.
