O R D E R

The counsel for the petitioner could not be connected. Even on the last occasion he was not connected.

In any case I do not find any merit in the petition. The petition is filed by the husband seeking transfer of a petition for maintenance filed by the respondent-wife under Section 125 CrPC. The transfer is sought from the Court in South 24 Parganas, West Bengal to a Court in Gajuwaka, Vishakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh which is about 900 kms away. The ground on which transfer is sought, is that the petitioner is ready to have the respondent in the matrimonial home and that the petitioner is working in Vishakhapatnam. But these grounds are not sufficient to transfer a petition for maintenance filed under Section 125 of CrPC.

Hence the transfer petition is dismissed.
