Four employees, who were found to have been employed on the basis of forged documents were removed from service vide order dated 03.11.1997. The challenge to those orders was accepted by the Central Administrative Tribunal vide common judgment dated 07.03.2002 directing reinstatement with 50% back wages. This order was confirmed by the High Court while dismissing four writ petitions preferred by Union of India. The matter was carried further by filing special leave petition in this Court. Maintaining the direction as regards reinstatement, this Court set aside the direction regarding payment of back wages.

The aforesaid order is subject matter of this review petition. We have gone through the review petition and do not find any error apparent on record. This review petition is, therefore, dismissed.
