O R D E R

1. On 29.03.2017, this Court passed the following order:-

"Mr. Sunil Kumar Gupta, alleged contemnor/respondent is present before this Court. It is an admitted fact that he has not given the undertaking, as directed in the order. It is also an admitted fact that the rent has not been paid.

Learned counsel for the alleged contemnor/respondent points out that he has been in deep trouble on account of his kidney failure and ongoing treatment.

Be that as it may, he has handed over the keys of the premises in question to the learned counsel for the petitioner. The petitioner may go and occupy the premises and submit a Report to this Court within a week.

The alleged contemnor/respondent may

also verify the statement of arrears of rent, which has been passed on to him by the learned counsel for the petitioner today.

Post on 12.04.2017.

The respondent is permitted to take back two air conditioners and three tables, which, according to him, belong to him."

2. Today, we are informed that the petitioner has taken the possession and what survives is only the issue of use and occupation charges, which we leave to the petitioner to work out in appropriate proceedings.

3. However, we are informed that towards dues of electricity consumption, water consumption and property tax during the period the respondent/alleged contemnor used the premises, approximately an amount of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs) is due. We direct the petitioner to pay the said amount of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs) to the respondent within a period of three months from today.

4. We make it clear that this order shall not prejudice the liberty available to the petitioner to work out the remedy for realization of use and occupation charges.

5. With the above observations and directions, the contempt petition is disposed of.
