**UPON hearing the counsel, the Court made the following  
O R D E R**

1. Application seeking exemption from filing official translation is allowed.
2. Learned counsel for the parties state that they have tried to negotiate an out of Court settlement, but have not succeeded. Both of them state that they are still open for a settlement.
3. Respondent is present in Court today.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has specified a figure for a one time settlement, which the other side has turned down as being unreasonable.
5. After some back and forth, both parties are agreeable that the respondent shall pay a sum of ₹15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs only) in full and final settlement of all the claims of the petitioner against him. On receiving the said amount, the petitioner shall withdraw the present petition, thereby accepting the impugned judgment dated 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2017, passed by the High Court declaring the marriage between the parties as null and void.
6. It is agreed that the sum of ₹15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs only) shall be paid by the respondent in the following manner:
  - (i) First instalment of ₹5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs) on or before 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2024.
  - (ii) Second instalment of ₹5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs) on or before 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2024.

(iii) Third instalment of ₹5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs) on or before 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2024.

7. It is made clear that if the respondent defaults in paying the instalments on or before the dates fixed above, the defaulted amount shall carry interest at the rate of 12% per annum.

8. The respondent shall file an affidavit within one week undertaking to pay the amounts as directed above to the petitioner through RTGS, on her furnishing the bank account details, within one week.

9. The Petition for Special Leave to Appeal is disposed of on the above terms.
