O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The grievance of the petitioner is that while
there is no objection to the direction of the Consumer
Fora to be complied with, executable direction ought to be
in terms of payment of money. According to the petitioner,
whatever amount was payable has been paid and if any
amount is due, the same will be paid.

Accordingly, we direct the District Forum,

Consumer Protection, Ajmer, to determine the amount payable by the petitioner, if any, in compliance of the impugned order. The petitioner may appear before the said forum on 5th February, 2018 for the said purpose.

Any coercive steps be taken only after an order is passed in terms of the present order.

If the respondents are aggrieved by the above order, they will be at liberty to move this Court.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
