O R D E R

This petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife for transfer of Case No.656/2016, titled as "Shaleen R. Harlalka vs. Shriya Shaleen Harlalka", pending before the Family Court at Udaipur, Rajasthan, to the Family Court, Mumbai, Maharashtra.

Having heard learned counsel appearing for the parties and upon perusal of the record, we decline to consider the transfer of the aforesaid case from the Family Court at Udaipur, Rajasthan, to the Family Court, Mumbai, Maharashtra.

However, we consider it appropriate in the interests of justice and in view of this Court's order dated 09.3.2017 passed in T.P.(C) No.1912 of 2014, titled as "Krishna Veni Nagam vs. Harish Nagam", to direct that the trial shall be conducted and facilitated by the Family Court at Udaipur, Rajasthan, through Video Conferencing.

We further direct that caution and care shall be taken by the Family Court at Udaipur, Rajasthan, to

ensure that the witnesses be examined in a place where there is no possibility of outside influence being exerted on them, in case a separate room for conducting video conferencing is not available.

With the aforesaid directions, the transfer petition stands disposed of.

Needless to mention that in case, the facility of video conferencing is not available in the Family Court at Udaipur, Rajasthan, the District Judge, Udaipur, shall provide the facility of video conferencing at a suitable place at Udaipur, Rajasthan.
