Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The order out of which this special leave petition arises is

simplicitor directing appearance of Respondent No.4 on 16.11.2017 and show cause was issued as to why the contempt proceedings be not undertaken.

In the circumstances as the order is laconic, let the reply be considered first. The High Court also to ensure that allegation of violation is within ken of the contempt jurisdiction and thereafter if it is considered appropriate to call for presence of Respondent No.4. It is open to call for personal presence of Respondent No.4. For the time being presence of Respondent No.4 may not be insisted.

Accordingly, the special leave petition is disposed of.

The High Court to decide the matter as expeditiously as possible.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.

W.P.(C) No. 148/2018

It is open to the petitioner to approach the High Court. However, at this stage only relief pressed is for consideration of the representation filed by the petitioner.

The State Government to consider the representation, as assured, within three months. In case the petitioner is aggrieved by the decision, it is open to him to question the decision before the High Court, in accordance with law, in appropriate proceedings.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of. Let the representation be filed within two weeks from today. Within three months thereafter it may be decided.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
