O R D E R

The petitioner is aggrieved by the refusal of anticipatory bail; he is accused of committing offences under Sections 406, 420 read 120-B IPC. While issuing notice the Court had directed to deposit a sum of ₹ 4,43,500/- within a period of two weeks. The office report indicates that the

direction was complied with. Learned counsel appearing for the State has entered appearance and filed a counter affidavit.

Having regard to the nature of the allegations against the petitioner and the fact that he has complied with the Court's order, we are of the opinion that he deserves to be granted relief. He is directed to be enlarged on bail subject to such conditions as the Trial Court may impose.

Amount shall be transmitted to the concerned Court to be dealt with in accordance with law having regard to the final order to be made.

The special leave petition is disposed of in terms of the above.
