UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. The High Court in exercise of its second appellate jurisdiction under Section 100 of the Code of Civil Procedure has reversed the judgment and decree of the trial court, since affirmed by the First Appellate Court, on the ground that the suit itself instituted by the appellant was time barred. It is noted that the appellant went unrepresented before the High Court.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the appellants has prayed for a short accommodation to address the court on the merits of the appeal.
3. Reluctantly, we adjourn hearing of this appeal by three weeks. It is made clear that no further prayer for adjournment shall be entertained.

4. Since the learned counsel for the State of Chhattisgarh is not present today and the respondents 4 and 5 are unrepresented, though service was effected at the initial stage, Registry is directed to issue fresh notice to the respondents informing the next date of hearing.
