- 1 Delay condoned.
- 2 The claim for compassionate appointment has been rejected. The father of the petitioner died in 1993. An application for compassionate appointment was made in 2010 by the spouse of the deceased employee for the appointment of the younger son as a Sub-Inspector, and when he did not fulfill the requirements of the appointment, for appointing the petitioner.

- 3 Compassionate appointment is made to tide over the immediate crisis which is faced by the family on the death of the employee who is the income-earner. Having regard to the lapse of nearly 27 years since the death of the employee, no error can be found in the judgment of the High Court rejecting the writ petition, which was filed in 2019.
- 4 The Special Leave Petition is accordingly dismissed.
- 5 Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
