Having heard learned counsel for the parties and regard being
had to the facts and circumstances of the case we are only inclined
to modify the sentence imposed on the appellant. Be it noted that
the learned Trial Court Judge has imposed a sentence of life

imprisonment under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code which the High Court has reduced to 10 years.

Considering the facts in its entirety we think that the cause of justice would be sub-served if the sentence is reduced to a period of 7 years.

With the aforesaid modification of sentence, the special leave petition stands disposed of.
