ORDER

Leave granted.

This appeal by special leave petition is directed against the judgment and order, dated 12.07.2016, passed by the High Court of Judicature at madras in Criminal Appeal No. 650 of 2015. The High Court while dismissing the appeal, confirmed the conviction and sentence imposed on the appellant by the Trial Court.

This Court on 31.03.2017, issued notice limited to question pertaining to the quantum of sentence.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the documents available on record.

After taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of this case as well as the mitigating factors, it would be appropriate to reduce the sentence of the

appellant from life imprisonment under Section 6 of the POSCO Act to 10 years, However the amount of fine of Rs. 10,000/- is enhanced to Rs. 25,000/-. Other sentences imposed on the appellant shall run concurrently.

The appeal is, accordingly, allowed partly.
