UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

By the impugned order, the petitioner has been denied interim suspension of bail during the pendency of a Criminal Revision Petition. The conviction is for an offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 in two complaints. The sentence is for a period of four months in respect of one complaint and six months in the other and both the sentences are to run concurrently.

We are informed that the High Court has posted the Criminal Revision Petition on 08.01.2018. Now that the High Court has

declined to grant interim suspension of bail, we request the High Court to dispose of the Criminal Revision Petition preferably on the next date of hearing. However, we make it clear that in case the disposal is delayed for any reason, it will be open to the petitioner to renew his prayer for suspension before the High Court.

In view of the above, this Special Leave Petition is disposed of.
