UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

We have perused the affidavit of Kumar Shyamal Parthsarathi,
Under Secretary, Deptt. of Financial Services, Ministry of Finance,
Government of India. In paragraph 7, now there is a categorical

assurance given to make compliance. However, longer time is sought in terms of paragraph 9.

Paragraph 7 of this affidavit reads thus:

"It is respectfully submitted that keeping in view the specific direction of this Hon'ble Court and prayers made in the Writ Petitions, Miscellaneous Applications and Interim Application as mentioned in Para 3 above, this respondent has further reconsidered the issue and decided to:

(I) Implement the pension scheme in respect of the employees of RRBs w.e.f. 01.11.1993, in terms of Memorandum of Settlement dated 29.10.1993 applicable to NCBs, and to pay consequential arrears of pension/family pension.

(II) Implement and grant computer increment w.e.f. 01.11.1993 to all employees who are in service/probation as on 01.11.1993 as per the Supplementary Memorandum of Settlement dated 29.10.1993 between Indian Banks' Association and Employees Associations of Nationalized Commercial Banks, along with payment of arrears thereof."

Before we consider the prayer for grant of longer time, we expect the respondents to pay at least a reasonable amount towards arrears by second week of October, 2024. Obviously, everybody must be paid at least current pension. Depending upon the compliance made by the respondents, we will consider the request for grant of longer time to make compliance.

The compliance shall be reported by the respondents by 18th October, 2024.
