In the course of hearing, a suggestion was given to Mr. V.N. Raghupathy, learned counsel appearing for the appellant whether the enhancement of the amount by Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees four lacs only) will satisfy the claim put forth in the appeal. Learned counsel accepted the same. Mrs. S.D. Raman, learned counsel appearing for the respondent, left it to the discretion of the Court.

In view of the aforesaid, the amount awarded is enhanced by aggregate Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees four lacs only) with the stipulation that the same shall be deposited before the Tribunal within twelve weeks hence, failing which it shall carry interest at the rate of 9% per annum from the date of application before the Tribunal. The amount deposited shall be disbursed in favour of the

appellant on proper identification.

With the aforesaid modification in the award passed by the tribunal, which has been further modified by the High Court, the appeal stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
