

"It is hereby made clear that no court shall entertain any grievance relating to this particular selection. Our present order would not dislodge, if any candidate, who has already been selected or sent for training. Needless to emphasize, the present order has been passed regard being had to the special features of the case."

These matters arise out of Selection to the post of constables in U.P. Police. The Selection was undertaken in the year 2011 and after noticing the overall picture presented by the learned Standing Counsel for the State, this Court had made the aforesaid observations. The intent was obviously to put a quietus to all challenges pertaining to the Selection.

It must be observed that even then a challenge in the form of Special Appeal No. 1220 of 2012 was dealt with by the Division bench of the High Court which by its judgment dated 18.01.2016 directed as under:

"Accordingly, all the petitioner-appellants who obtained 50% or more marks in the Hindi Essay Paper in the first evaluation of answer sheet shall be treated as successful in Hindi Essay paper. The respondents will as a consequence declare result of all above petitioners-appellants and petitioner-non appellant/intervenor Suresh Chandra, within two months from the date of the production of a certified copy of this order."

Ms. Garima Prasad, learned advocate for the State submits that except the persons involved in the said Special Appeal No. 1220 of 2012, no other person has been granted benefit in the light of directions issued by this court in its order dated 10.08.2015.

The Selection was of the year 2011. Nine years have gone by. At this length of time, it is extremely difficult to keep on entertaining challenges with respect to alleged mistakes or

irregularities in connection with the Selection process. It was in this light that the aforesaid directions were issued by this court on 10.08.2015.

We, therefore, see no reason to issue any clarification. This special leave petition therefore stands dismissed.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
