O R D E R

As per Order dated 08.05.19, the petitioner has not filed the affidavit showing that he has paid maintenance of about Rs.16,00,000/-. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready with affidavit today and seeks some time to file the same. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent taking notice of the same raises strong objection in adjourning the matter.

We have heard Mr. Mayilsamay K., learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. M.A. Chinnasamy, learned counsel appearing for the respondent on merits.

We do not find any good ground warranting interference with the impugned order in exercise of our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution of India.

The special leave petition is accordingly dismissed.

At this stage, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner requests for some time for payment of the amount in lieu of 87 sovereign of gold jewels ordered to be paid to the wife. Learned counsel for the respondent-wife has no serious objection for granting time. Learned counsel for the petitioner-husband also submits that the petitioner would regularly pay maintenance of Rs.35,000/- (Rs.25,000/- plus Rs.10,000/-) to the respondent-wife.

In view of above, the petitioner is granted one year time from today to pay the amount in lieu of 87 sovereign gold jewels. In case the petitioner does not pay the amount, as above, the respondent is at liberty to execute the decree in accordance with law.

Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
