Mr. Mukul Rohatgi, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to file review petition before the High Court primarily for challenging the adoption of 601 days as a denominator.

Permission, as sought for, is granted.

Accordingly, the special leave petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
