O R D E R

The parties are present in person. The petitioner/Mantri Varaha Narasimha Kiran Kumar has handed over four Demand Drafts for a total sum of Rs.4,45,000/- to the respondent/Mantri Aravinda. The respondent/Mantri Aravinda submits that some more amounts are due.

In the order dated 8.5.2017, this Court has observed that the orders regarding travel expenses would be passed on the date of hearing the matter. An amount of Rs.25,000/- is fixed towards travel expenses. As far as the remaining grievances are concerned,

the parties are free to agitate before the appropriate forum. The amount of Rs.25,000/- towards travel expenses will be paid within two months.

The respondent/Mantri Aravinda submits that she has been in litigation for around ten years. We direct that the following cases, pending before the Courts concerned shall be disposed of expeditiously and in any case within six months from today.

1. FCOP No.1253/2013 pending before Addl. Family Court, Vishakhapatnam.

2. FCOP No.1499/2011 pending before Addl. Family Court, Vishakapatnam.

3. C.C. No.773/2012 pending before 1st Addl. Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vishakhapatnam.

In case the husband does not cooperate, the Courts concerned shall take steps to ensure that he appears before the Court and cooperate with the proceedings.

The special leave petitions are disposed of, as above.
