A W A R D

1. The dispute between the parties has been referred for determination to the Lok Adalat.

2. We have persuaded the Officers of the Insurance Company ('Petitioner') to take an extremely compassionate view of this matter. Taking into consideration the peculiar facts and circumstances, though, there are arguable points on the side of the Insurance Company, they have agreed to withdraw the present special leave petition. However, the question of law is kept open to be determined in an appropriate case.

3. The special leave petition stands disposed of in terms of the Award.

4. The amount deposited by the Insurance Company along with the interest accrued thereupon, if such interest is lying in a nationalized bank, shall be paid to the family of the deceased, without any additional liability towards interest on the Insurance Company.
