Learned counsel for the appellant submits that by way of over implication, she has been named and summoning under Section 319 Crl.P.C is not justified. It is submitted that normally the husband and his parents may be involved in demand of dowry unless there is a specific material to justify implication of other relations. In the present case summoning of the appellant is not called for.

We find merit in the submission. Accordingly, we set aside the impugned order and quash the summoning of the appellant.

The appeal is allowed in above terms.
