O R D E R

Delay in filing Review Petitions is condoned.

Bhawana Menghani, daughter-in-law of the review petitioner had filed Transfer Petition (C) No.104 of 2016 seeking transfer of Original Suit No.129 of 2015 titled “Rani Gopaldas Punjabi and another v. Smt. Bhawna Menghani and 10 others” pending at Hyderabad to a court of competent jurisdiction at Delhi. The said Original Suit was filed by the review petitioner for partition claiming rights in terms of Will dated 19.12.2013 said to have been executed by her son Prakash (Husband of said Bhawana). By order dated 10.10.2017 the transfer petition filed Bhawana Menghani was allowed.

Transfer Petition (C) Nos.905/2015 and 924/2015 were filed by the review petitioner seeking transfer of (i) Civil Suit No.279 of 2014 filed by Bhawana Menghani in the court of Saket, New Delhi to Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh (ii) Succession Case No.60 of 2014 filed by Bhawana Menghani in Saket Court, New Delhi to Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh.

Since the proceedings were filed by the parties against each other and were pending in different courts, the idea was to have the proceedings at one place and, therefore Transfer Petition (C) Nos.908 and 924 of 2015 seeking transfer of proceedings from New Delhi to Hyderabad were rejected.

Exception is taken to said order passed by this Court.

We have gone through the contents of review petitions and do not find any reason to take a different view in the matter. These review petitions are, therefore, dismissed.
