O R D E R

1. Mr. A.K. Sinha, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the notice in this case was issued on 11-12-2019, the counsel despite many efforts, was unable to receive any further instructions from the petitioner. It is then pointed out that the challenge here is to order for maintenance passed in favour of the wife and the two daughters, born to the couple, under the High Court's order dated 17-7-2019.

2. The Office Report dated 6-2-2024 indicates that although notice was duly served on the respondents, they have not entered their appearance so far.

3. Only limited notice was issued on 11-12-2019 to explore the possibility of amicable settlement in the matrimonial dispute. The respondents have not appeared and the counsel for the petitioner is

4. Accordingly, we see no purpose in keeping the matter pending and the same is ordered to be disposed of.
