O R D E R

It is apparent from the record that a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. (C.R.R.No.1924 of 2018) has been filed in the High Court of Calcutta seeking quashing of proceedings pursuant to FIR No. 256/2018 dated 03.06.2018. Notice was issued by the High Court in that matter on 27.07.2018 and according to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the matter is still pending consideration.

The principal prayer in the writ petition is to seek transfer of investigation from Calcutta to Delhi. But the submissions advanced in the petition are projected with the idea that the entire case as advanced in the FIR is completely un-statable. In the circumstances, we do not consider it appropriate to entertain this writ petition and give liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate application for expeditious disposal of the pending application before the High Court.

In case, such an application is filed within fifteen days, we request the High Court to disposed of the aforesaid CRR No.1924 of 2018 as expeditiously as possible and preferably before 28.02.2020.

We shall not be taken to have reflected on merits of the submissions which shall be gone into independently at every stage.

This writ petition is disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, shall also stands disposed of.
