UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners as well as learned Additional Solicitor General appearing on behalf of the respondents.

2. We are not impressed with the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are entitled for supply of the power without depositing the arrears.

3. These special leave petitions have been filed only against the interim order dated 16.11.2017 passed by the High Court and still the matter has to be examined by the Division Bench of the High Court.

4. In the circumstances, we direct the petitioners to deposit the outstanding dues of Rs.33,68,212/- (Rupees thirty three lacs sixty eight thousand two hundred and twelve only), as demanded by the respondent(s) in the letter dated 8.1.2014, for the time being, within a period of four weeks' from today. If the petitioners fail to deposit the said amount, the respondents are at liberty to disconnect the power supply.

5. In view of the fact that the matter is still pending before the Division Bench of the High Court, the parties are at liberty to raise all the pleas before it.

6. The special leave petitions are disposed of with the above observations.
