Since the High Court is seized of the proceedings in CWP No 19675 of 2019 and is monitoring the entire issue pertaining to the carving out of vending and non-vending zones, we are not inclined to exercise our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution.

This is eminently a matter where objections, if any, should be addressed to and considered by the High Court so that a holistic view of the entire process can be

formed. For these reasons, we leave it open to the petitioners to bring the grievance to the notice of the High Court.
