**ORDER**

- 1 Leave granted.
- 2 The appellant has been denied anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 by a judgment dated 4 October 2019 of a Single Judge of the High Court of Madhya Pradesh.
- 3 The appellant has been implicated in FIR No 501/2019, registered at Police Station Gadarwara, District Narsinghpur in Madhya Pradesh and is alleged to have committed offences under Sections 294, 506 and 384 of the Indian Penal Code.
- 4 By an order dated 19 November 2019, this Court while issuing notice, has granted interim stay of arrest till the next date of listing. In pursuance of the order of this Court, the State of Madhya Pradesh has entered appearance through Mr Anshuman Shrivastava, Panel counsel. Mr Shrivastava states that a charge-sheet has been filed on 16 December 2019. Learned counsel also states that the respondent had appeared at that stage.
- 5 Hence, we permit the appellant to appear before the trial court and apply for regular bail. The trial court shall enlarge the appellant on bail, subject to such terms and conditions as may be imposed by it.

6 The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

7 Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
