Learned counsel for the petitioners says that there was a huge break in service of the respondents and the relevant material showing that the respondents were not similarly placed as other persons who obtained the benefit of the order passed in Writ Petition No.36623 of 2004 was filed in the High Court along with the memo of appeal. However, it

was not adverted to by the High Court and it was concluded that no material was filed by the petitioners herein.

If that is so, the petitioners may file a review petition before the High Court placing the correct facts on records.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks leave to withdraw the petition with liberty to approach the High Court.

Leave and liberty granted.

The special leave petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

The review petition may be filed by the petitioners within three weeks and the same should be decided on merits without going into the question of limitation.

The contempt petition may be kept pending till the review petition is taken up for consideration.
