O R D E R

1. Having heard learned Attorney General, at some length, we find no justification in interfering with the impugned order, at this stage, since the matter has not yet attained finality before the High Court.

2. We inquired from the learned Attorney General, the reasons of the adamant attitude adopted by the authorities, referred to in the impugned order. It was suggested, that an appropriate apology will be tendered to the High Court with an explanation, indicating the reasons of the delayed action, as also the commitment, to hereinafter ensure, that orders passed by the High Court will be faithfully implemented.

3. We are of the considered view, that the suggestion made by learned Attorney General, is most appropriate. We therefore, hereby allow liberty to the petitioners, as also the concerned officer(s), to tender an appropriate apology

to the High Court, along with an explanation for the alleged delay, for not being able to abide by the High Court's directions. And even if there has been a lapse, to tender a commitment, that such lapse will not occur in future.

4. We are also hopeful, that in the event of the petitioners and the officers adopting the aforesaid course, the High Court will consider the same graciously, and pass an appropriate order, in consonance with law.

5. The special leave petitions and connected applications are disposed of.
