O R D E R

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, the Court is of the opinion that the claim in these proceedings is justified.

Accordingly, HMOP No.4111/2016 titled as *Mrs. Janani Kamalesh v. Sukumar Ravi* and O.P. No.1709/2017 titled as *R. Sukumar v. Mrs. Janani*, both pending before the Sixth Additional Judge, Family Court, Chennai Tamil Nadu are hereby transferred to the Family Court at Bangalore, Karnataka.

The transferor Court shall forthwith transmit the entire record relating to the aforesaid case to the transferee Court for deciding the case in accordance with law.

The transferee Court at Bangalore shall endeavour to complete the proceedings after initially referring the parties to mediation for an amicable resolution of their disputes. In any event, the transferee Court shall decide the requests of the rival parties i.e. pending application by the petitioner-wife for *ad interim* maintenance and *pedente lite* litigation expenses as well as any application by the respondent-husband claiming visitation rights in respect of the parties' minor child, as early as possible,

preferably within eight weeks from the date the Court receives the papers. The parties shall also cooperate in the proceedings and shall not take any unnecessary adjournments.

The Transfer Petitions are allowed in the above terms.
