Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner on behalf of the Supreme Court Legal Services Committee submits that the petitioner has already completed actual imprisonment of about 13 years six months.

In the premises, we direct:

- a. The concerned Jail Authorities shall immediately facilitate and assist the petitioner in making an appropriate application seeking commutation/remission;
- b. Let the needful in that behalf be done within two weeks from the receipt of the copy of this order;
- c. The application so preferred shall be transmitted to the concerned State Authorities, who shall immediately take appropriate decision in respect of such application.
- d. Let the decision be taken within four weeks from the receipt of the communication from the Jail Authorities, as directed above.
- e. The decision taken by the competent Authority shall then be communicated to the petitioner and if any reprieve is granted, the appropriate benefit shall immediately be conferred upon the petitioner.

Ordered accordingly.

The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
