



**W.P.(Cr1.) No. 27/2019:**

By our order dated 14.05.2018, the petitioner was enlarged on bail subject to certain conditions. In a Prevention of Money Laundering Act proceeding, which has necessarily to go by the predicate offence, the petitioner is now sought to be arrested.

We allow the petitioner to appear before the Trial Court within two weeks from today.

The petitioner shall then be at liberty to file a bail application, which will be considered by the Trial Court forthwith. Even if the application is rejected, the petitioner shall not be arrested for a period of 30 days in order to enable him to approach the higher forum.

With this observation, this Writ Petition is disposed of.

**W.P.(Cr1.) No. 31/2019:**

Learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the Writ Petition.

Permission granted.

The Writ Petition is allowed to be withdrawn.

However, the bail application that is listed on 08.02.2019 before the Lucknow bench of the Allahabad High Court must be taken up and disposed of, preferably on the same day itself.
