O R D E R

We have heard learned counsel for the parties and also perused the record.

We are not inclined to interfere with the conviction and sentence awarded to the petitioners. However, since it is pointed out that petitioner - Majjal is 96 years of age and suffering from illness, he need not surrender forthwith. If he applies for remission under Article 161 of the Constitution of India on the ground of advance age and ill health within one month, the said application be decided within six months and till such decision is taken, he will not be taken into custody.

Qua Majjal, the special leave petition is disposed of.

Qua petitioner - Sattar, the special leave petition is dismissed.
