O R D E R

While rejecting the Letters Patent Appeal, the Division Bench of the High Court had observed:

“In the instant case, the respondent Nos.6 and 7 are the companies registered under the Companies Act, 1956 with no manner of control either administrative or otherwise of the Central Government, the shares of the said organizations are not being held and controlled by the Central Government. The nature of the employment is purely private in nature. It has no statutory flavour. Moreover, the question is whether the writ petitioner has been wrongfully and illegally discriminated are the disputes which are in the private domain and needs to be adjudicated in an appropriate proceeding and not a writ proceeding.”

The view so taken was affirmed while dismissing Special Leave Petition arising therefrom.

We have gone through the grounds raised in the Review Petition and do not find any error apparent on record to justify interference in Review Jurisdiction.

This Review Petition is, therefore, dismissed.
