Civil Appeal NO.18273 of 2017 and batch matters have been disposed of by this Court by Order dated 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2017 in and by which this Court has remitted the case back to the High Court to decide the matters afresh, inter alia, on the various aspects, as

observed by this Court, in accordance with law. This Court has also requested the High Court to decide the matters as far as possible within six months.

The present special leave petition also arises out of the same judgment of the High Court dated 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2016 and this special leave petition is disposed of in terms of the said order dated 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2017 passed by this Court.

Insofar as C.M.W.P.No.4986 of 2005 (subject matter of this Special Leave Petition NO.3426 of 2017) status quo, as ordered by this Court vide Order dated 6<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 shall be maintained by the parties till the disposal of the matter by the High Court.

We request the High Court to hear and decide the batch matters at an early date, preferably within a period of three months from today.

Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
