O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the impugned order passed by the High Court at New Delhi. We do not find any ground to interfere with the impugned order except to strike off paragraphs 28, 29 and 30 contained in the said order. The special leave petition is dismissed with the aforesaid observation.

However, the petitioner is granted three months' time from today to hand over the peaceful vacant possession of the premises in question to the respondent subject to his filing a usual undertaking within a period of one week from today. The petitioner shall also pay arrears of rent/mesne profit, if any, within a period of two weeks and shall also pay regularly mesne profits every month by the first week of the succeeding month.
