ORDER

1. Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

2. The prayer of transfer in the present transfer petition has been opposed by the respondent, *inter alia*, on the ground that the distance between Kotputli, District Jaipur, Rajasthan where the proceedings are pending and Rewari, Haryana to which place the transfer has been prayed for is about 80 kms. and the traveling time is one and half hours.

3. The materials on record would indicate that the petitioner is residing in Rewari, Haryana and she has a minor child to look after. In these circumstances, we deem it proper to allow the prayer for transfer. Therefore, Petition No.13 of 2016, titled as "Anil Saini vs. Santosh Devi",

pending in the Court of Senior District & Sessions Judge at Kotputli, District Jaipur, Rajasthan is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Rewari, Haryana. The Court of Senior District & Sessions Judge at Kotputli shall send the case record to the transferee Court promptly and without any delay.

4. The transfer petition is accordingly allowed.

5. After transfer of the petition, the transferee Court is directed to make all endeavour for amicable settlement, failing which for early decision in the case without unnecessary adjournments.
